

# Sure Nuff Fast

Sure Nuff Fast, a 1997 bay mare (Bills Ryon AQHA x Wego For Cash) bred by David Mackie of Houston, Texas, and owned by Gary Vaughan of Coalgate, Oklahoma, earned an automatic induction into the ApHC Hall of Fame for exemplary production. She is the latest inductee in the powerhouse dynasty of a Hall of Fame racing bloodline that includes Wego Melody (1988), Scooter Bug G. (1993) and Wego For Cash (2000).



As a yearling, Sure Nuff Fast grew up in Mammoth Springs, Arkansas, and at 5 began her broodmare career, foaling Jstcallme Brisco (2003) and G I Jana (2005). After G I Jana was born, Vaughan bought her and brought her to Oklahoma, her permanent home state. She passed through a few owners in the late 2000s, when Rocket Ball (2007), Lady star Dancer (2008) and Ivory Queen (2009) were foaled. In 2010 Sure Nuff Fast returned home to Vaughan; General Wave (2011) and Ivory King (2012) are her final foals.

Out of these seven registered foals, five have earned bronze medallions. G I Jana leads with four bronze medallions (2007 Racing – 2-Year-Old Filly; 2008 Racing – Three-Year-Old Filly; 2009 Racing – Aged Mare; 2010 Racing – Aged Mare), and Ivory Queen is second with two (2011 Racing – 2-Year Old Filly; 2012 Racing – 3-Year-Old Filly). General Wave (2013 Racing – 2-Year-Old Colt), Lady Star Dancer (2010 racing – 2-Year-Old Filly) and Rocket Ball (2011 Racing – Aged Geldings) each have one.

As a racing mare, Sure Nuff Fast placed third in the 1999 American Appaloosa Futurity in Oklahoma City. Between 1999 and 2001, she had 13 starts and four wins, with total earnings of \$17,060 and a 2000 bronze medallion in racing as 3-year-old filly. She passed on her greatness to her foals, who amassed an impressive \$188,643. As with the medallions, G I Jana leads with \$98,377 in earnings, followed by Ivory Queen with \$47,398.

“She was a great brood mare, a heck of a race horse who passed on color and conformation to her babies,” Vaughan said. Sure Nuff Fast died in 2013 at the age of 16.
