

ALL HANDS ON ZIP

THE BIG RED, blanketed 1992 stallion, All Hands On Zip (Zippo Jack Bar (QH) x All Hands On Deck) proudly takes his place in the history of the breed through automatic induction into the Appaloosa Horse Club Hall of Fame for having sired at least 40 Bronze Medallion-earning foals.

Bred by Judith A. De Muth of Clinton, Michigan, All Hands On Zip has been proudly owned by Walt and Nancy Magnussen of College Station, Texas, and Curt and Debra Kennelly of Valparaiso, Indiana since 2003. His highly successful breeding program at the Magnussen's Hopes Creek Ranch has produced 344 foals who have so far accumulated 4,697.5 performance points, 4,176.0 halter points, 198 Registers of Merit, 24 Halter Superior Events, 8 Performance Superior Events, 25 Club Champions, 8 Versatility Champions, 78 Bronze and 28 Silver Medallions.

A multiple medallion-earner himself, All Hands On Zip established his own success in the show ring, racking up 5 World Championships before retiring to the stud barn, including two wins in the highly competitive Junior Hunter Under Saddle event with Nancy Sue Ryan in the irons in 1995 and 1997, and he prevailed in the prestigious Hunter In Hand Stallion class with Rob Meneely in 1999. Proving true versatility, which he is known to pass on to his get, he earned Non-Pro and Open Registers of Merit in both Western Pleasure and Hunter Hack.
