THE 2001 MARE Joyball by Whirling Fastball (QH) and out of Easy Boppin' Jones is only the sixth mare in the history of the Appaloosa Horse Club to be inducted into the Hall of Fame with five or more foals to earn Racing Bronze Medallions.

Bred by Joy N. Holder-Smith of Coalgate, Oklahoma, and owned by Gary Vaughan, also of Coalgate, Joyball had a successful racing career in her own right before retiring as a broodmare. She raced between 2003 and 2005 with lifetime stats of 17 starts, 2 wins, 3 place, 1 show for \$20,311.00, and earned a 2004 Bronze Racing Medallion - 3-Year-Old Filly.

Five of her registered foals have earned six Bronze Racing Medallions, including Lady Joy (14 starts, 1 win, 2 place, 1 show for \$12,985), Poker Lil (11 starts, 1 win, 1 place, 3 shows for \$11,395), Cobra Cash (14 starts, 2 wins, 2 place for \$19,209) and her 2014 foal and 2016 2-Year-Old Racing Gelding, Col Bucks (pictured), who is just getting started with \$38,316 so far. It was her 2009 foal that earned two Medallions and captured the hopes of many before his untimely death. Captain Bucko had 16 starts, 8 wins, 3 place 1 show for \$116,061; and the 2012 Paul Harbor Memorial Handicap.
