



The 2001 dark bay mare Love A Diva has proven such prowess as a broodmare that she has been issued a Bronze Supreme Dam Production Plaque and automatically inducted into the Appaloosa Horse Club Hall of Fame. She was bred by Hall of Famer Victoria Ennis of Kingston, Oklahoma, and has been owned since 2005 by Brianne Doolittle of Coral Springs, Florida. She is out of the Thoroughbred mare Gladja Came and carries on the Hall of Fame bloodline through her sire of I Love Willie, Bull Nunneley, and MR Spotted Bull.

She has an impressive show record in her own right that includes four World and two National Championships, six Reserve Championships, seven Top-Five and eight Top-Ten honors. She has accrued 460 lifetime points in Youth, Open, and Non-Pro events, in everything from Showmanship to equitation and pleasure (bareback, English, and western), and Hunter In Hand to Halter events. She has earned six Registers of Merit, four Year-End Top Tens, a Superior Event, and three Bronze Medallions.

Love A Diva's five registered foals include four Performance Point Earners for 126 points, five Halter Point Earners for 177 points, one Club Champion, and have achieved eight Registers of Merit, a Halter Superior Event, and the following Bronze Medallions: Love My Art with four, Loves So Sweet with three, Love My Design with two, Lovin N Leavin and Designed For Divas with one each. Loves So Sweet is by Sweet As Chocolate, her other four foals are all by Artfully Designed. Together they have amassed 510.5 combined lifetime points (as of this writing).

Like her sire and grandsires before her, congratulations to Love A Diva as she deservedly takes her place in the Appaloosa Horse Club Hall of Fame.
