

C Almosta Blond

The first horse to win the coveted Youth Supreme Champion Horse title in 1997, 17 years after the Appaloosa Youth Association was formed, C Almosta Blond (The Dirt Boss [QH] x Miss Absarokoe Bar), "Blondie," has been inducted into the Appaloosa Horse Club Hall of Fame. Nominated by owner Niceene Connolly, Blondie served the Connolly family as a youth show horse for many years, performing admirably at the Youth World Show over many years through the 1990s, and winning numerous year-end high points in youth categories, under the ridership of Niceene's daughter Amber.

Blondie lived to the ripe old age of 30, and produced a couple trail horses. Prior to her 2015 death, she served as lead-line horse for Amber's niece and nephew.

Over her 30-year life, Blondie accumulated an impressive 1,411.5 points, mostly in the youth classes, but with some open and non-pro results as well.
