

Cash Blues

1986 Mare

Cash Blues foaled in 1986 and raced for three seasons, 1988-1990. Sired by Roll The Cash (QH) X Shavano's Blues, her 12 wins, 3 place, 3 show from 30 starts produced career earnings of \$57,330. 1988 was the filly's best year with 6 wins, 1 place, 2 show and earnings of \$43,745. She was her sire's first of 29 starters to race, his first to earn a Bronze Racing Medallion, and first to garner an ERC award, 1988 Champion Distance 2-Year-Old-Filly. Ranking near the top of all Roll The Cash starters, she was his fourth highest money earner and third with Most Wins.

Blues' notable wins include her trial heat and Finals of the 1988 Cricket Bars Futurity, the Okie Summer Futurity trial heat and Finals, and finishing 2nd in the Finals of the Kansas Sunflower Classic Futurity after winning her trial. She also set a new 440-yard track record in 1989 at Remington Park, topping off her career in 1990 with three different Paint/Appaloosa Allowance wins. 11 of her 12 foals raced from 1996 through 2011, earning



\$94,339, with three being awarded a Bronze Racing Medallion and eight running fast enough to earn a Register of Merit.

Cash Blues was bred by Danny and Sheila McIntyre of Norman, Oklahoma, raised by Flying Eagle Stables, and retired with Appaloosa Racing Hall of Famers Kim and Kay Pirtle also of Norman, Oklahoma.
