Eyesa Knockout was raced lightly as a two- and three-year-old but she has made her mark in history as a broodmare. Her first five foals all raced and all earned at least one Bronze Medallion, a success so great it automatically elevates her into the ApHC Hall of Fame.

Bred by Ronald Fowler of Mammoth Springs, Arkansas, Eyesa Knockout is by Mr. Eye Opener (QH), out of Wego For Cash, and owned since 2010 by Gary Vaughan of Coalgate, Oklahoma. She is proving to pass on a nearly dynastic, Hall of Fame, Apaloosa racing line that began with Wego Melody in 1962 and has continued through We Go Easy, We Go Charge, Some Kinda Easy, Easy We Go, Scooter Bug G., Eyesa's dam Wego For Cash, and Eyesa's third foal Major Tom (also inducted this year).

Eyesa Knockout closed out 2018 as the Leading Dam Based On Dollars Earned with \$90,170. Her five Hall of Fame-qualifying foals are by four different stallions and have earned a total of 9 Bronze Medallions as follows: 2006 gelding Eyesa Dasher (by Royal Flick Dash (QH)) with one Bronze; 2010 mare Panda Doll (by Real Visions (QH)) with two Bronzes; 2011 gelding Major Tom (by Red Storm Cat (QH)) with three Bronzes; 2014 stallion Gray Chief (by Ivory James (QH)) with two Bronzes; and 2016 gelding Admiral Tom (by Red Storm Cat (QH)) with one Bronze.
