She's A Fancy Zippo, "Ginger," (Zippo Pine Bar x She's Kinda Fancy), a 1993 mare, has been inducted into the ApHC Hall of Fame for her stellar achievements in Western Pleasure. Bred by Nancy Laurie in Columbia, Missouri, she quickly found a home with Phil and Mary Hug in Virginia.

As a two-year-old at the 1995 World Show, she won open Two-Year-Old Western Pleasure, as well as first place in both the Open and the Limited Futurity for the Appaloosa Pleasure Horse Association. She went on to receive a lifetime total of 12 National and World championships and nine reserves, as well as 13 open and non-pro awards. In addition to Western Pleasure, she excelled at Western Riding late in life, winning a 2001 World championship and a 2003 National championship in that class. She earned 370.5 points in her lifetime.

Ginger produced three foals, two of which have been outstand-



ing performers. Gingers Hunter has accumulated 237.5 points in youth classes as well as 37.5 performance points, and Zs Fancy Impulse has earned 260 performance points.

After her show career ended in 2003, Ginger served as a training and Dressage horse at Scripture Farm in Virginia, with Debbie Scripture and her students. Ginger took to Dressage naturally. She passed away in December 2016.
