**I**nvaluable is a 2007 gelding by Inpassable (A Passing Breeze (QH) x Pass My Image) and out of The Passing Lane (Zippo Pine Bar (QH) x The Fast Lane). He joins the Appaloosa Horse Club Hall of Fame with 15 bronze

medallions and 605.5 lifetime points in Open, Non-Pro and Youth, earning an automatic induction.

His impressive show record includes 171.5 points in Open Senior Trail and 117.5 points in Open Senior Western Riding, and he is still being shown at the time of this writing. He has earned eight total Registers of Merit, four Open, two Non-Pro, and two Youth, as well as three Superior Event awards. His 15 bronze medallions are comprised of nine in Western Riding and six in Trail. He showed at his first World Championship Show in 2008 in Yearling Longe Line, and has since won 26 World and National Champion titles, 20 Reserve World and National Championships, 23 Top Fives, and 30 Top Tens.

He was bred by David S. Hogan of Laveen, Arizona, purchased from Kaitlin Bowen by Beck Farms of Stockton, California, in 2010, and was campaigned in Youth by Mary and Abigail Beck from 2010 until 2013. The Keller Family purchased him in 2013 and sold him to Megan Holtmeyer of Parker, Colorado, in 2015, who owns him currently and has since shown him to great success in Non-Pro. His recent success in Open classes has been predominantly with trainer, Jesse Jones.
