## Appaloosa Horse Club *Hall Of Fame*

**W**illiam Grant, a 2013 gelding, is the first foal by ApHC Hall of Fame Stallion All Hands On Zip to also be inducted into the ApHC Hall of Fame. All Hands On Zip (Zippo Jack Bar (QH) x All Hands On Deck) was automatically inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2015 for having sired at least 40 Bronze Medallion-earning foals. William Grant, out of My Zips Too Sleepy (Too Sleepy To Zip (QH) x Ha-Dar No Regrets), follows his sire into the Hall of Fame on an automatic induction with nine Silver Medallions and three Bronze Medallions.

He competed in his first World Championship Show in 2014 where he won his first World Champion trophy in Open Hunter in Hand, Yearling Colts in the hand of Dale Sullens, and his first Reserve World Champion trophy in Non-Pro Yearling Longe Line, Hunter with Sid Karr. Since then, he has racked up 289 total lifetime points in Open and Non-Pro competition, 21 World and National Championship titles, 10 Reserve World and National Championships, 16 Top Fives, and nine Top Tens. Throughout his show career, he has earned five Open Registers of Merit, two Non-Pro Registers of Merit, one Non-Pro Club Championship, one Open Club Championship, 12 Open Year End Top Tens, five Territory High Points, and one Versatility Championship.

William Grant was bred by Nancy Magnussen of College Station, Texas. He has been shown with great success by Dale Sullens, Sid Karr, Sidney Mariah Karr, Kelly Zacharias, Mason Colins, Lisa Ligon, and Holly Janak. The Appaloosa Horse Club congratulates William Grant and all those connected to his successful show career for his well-deserved induction into the ApHC Hall of Fame.
