791- SHOWMANSHIP .
Western & English Showmanship at Halter
Penalties:

P-2) g. 3 Point Penalties:

- * Switching pivot foot.
- * Horse resting a foot or hipshot in a setup.

P-2) f. 5 Point Penalties:

- * Blatant disobediences including biting, kicking, rearing, pawing,
Horse continually circling exhibitor.

723- TRAIL.
Disqualifications

E- 1) p

Walk Trot and Novice Classes Only:

- * Exhibitors going off pattern, knocking over or on wrong
side of cone, never performing specified gait, or over
turning more than 1/4 turn than designated, shall not
be disqualified, but must always place below exhibitors
not incurring disqualifying fault.

723- WALK TROT TRAIL. (REMOVE the below rule)

J -2). If the horse breaks into a lope for more than 3 consecutive
strides, it shall be disqualified.

794-WALK TROT EQUITATION/ HORSEMANSHIP
(REMOVE the below rule)

E . If the horse breaks into a lope for more than 3 consecutive
strides, it shall be disqualified.

G-2) In Green, Novice, Walk Trot Classes, poles cannot be elevated.

2. 1 Point Penalties:
 - d. One to two steps on mount/dismount or ground tie, except shifting to balance.
- 3 . 3 Point Penalties:
 - e. Three to four steps on mount/dismount or ground tie.
4. 5 Point Penalties:
 - j. Five or more steps on mount/dismount or ground tie.

After much discussion by all, these were the rule proposals
Decided on by the JAC to be submitted for approval.
Perhaps using Rule 70, for immediate inclusion on some or all
Of the rule proposals if possible.

Doug discussed the use of extended gaits in
Western Pleasure Classes.

714 GENERAL PERFORMANCE RULES:

E. It is permissible for a judge to require an exhibitor to extend
the Walk, Jog/ Trot or Lopecanter unless otherwise specified.
Doug stated that it is legal and he often calls for an extended
Lopecanter when he judges.
