Each year, the Appaloosa Horse Club awards three regional clubs with the ApHC Exemplary Regional Club Awards. The top three submissions receiving the award also win \$500 (first place), \$300 (second place), and \$100 (third place.) These clubs submit a presentation and are assessed in 27 qualifying areas. Areas include but are not limited to Trail Ride, Social Media, Clinics, and Club Membership.

The 2022 first-place ApHC Exemplary Regional Club Award recipient was the Keystone Appaloosa Club.

The Keystone Appaloosa Club is located in Pennsylvania and has 63 members as of 2022. 27 of these members are nonpro riders and 25 of them are youth.

This club holds different events for their members such as their Year-End Award Banquet, Clinics, and they were a part of the 2022 GEAR Appaloosa Show.

The club is sure to recognize their members' hard work. One of the ways they do this is through a youth scholarship. The scholarships are distributed at the Pennsylvania 4H State Show. They are given to the highest placing Western and English Riders.
