- 1. This scholarship is open to any high school senior who intends to attend college, partake in an apprenticeship program, or attend a vocational/trade school.
- 2. The Appaloosa Youth Association (AYA) must receive evidence of either enrollment forms from a college, trade school, or apprenticeship program or a copy of the applicant's term bill or grades to demonstrate that the AYA can send the awardee the funds. The AYA must receive this evidence by no later than December 31st of the year the scholarship is awarded. The scholarship will be forfeited if this requirement is not fulfilled by December 31st. The AYA will not send funds until this requirement is fulfilled.
- 3. Applicants must provide proof of being a high school senior via unofficial transcripts.
- 4. Applicants must be a current ApHC youth member.
- 5. Applicants must write a 450-700 word essay explaining what they intend to do with the degree/program they enter into (e.g., what will they get out of it, why do it, how will it further their career, career goals/ambitions, etc.)
- 6. Applicants must write a 300 word essay about how the Appaloosa horse has influenced their life.
