

Mission

The Appaloosa Horse Club (ApHC) honors the heritage and promotes the future of the Appaloosa horse.



History

The Appaloosa Horse Club was established in Oregon in 1938 with the goal of preserving, promoting and enhancing the Appaloosa breed. From those first few enthusiasts, the Club has grown into one of the leading equine breed registries in the world. The ApHC has since registered more than 700,000 Appaloosas. In September 1947, the Club headquarters was moved to Moscow, Idaho. In 1974, the ApHC purchased a building and moved into its current home less than 200 feet from the Washington-Idaho border. The Palouse region of the Northwest is an appropriate home for the organization; the Appaloosa's historic background is linked to the region, and the word "Appaloosa" evolved from the words "A Palouse Horse." Today, Appaloosas are one of the most beloved American horse breeds and can be found throughout the world excelling in nearly every equine discipline. Their color, intelligence, athleticism and trustworthy temperament have made them one of the most unique and popular horses in the equine industry.

The 76th National Appaloosa Show will be held this year in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma in the historic Jim Norick Arena. This show is the nation's longest running single breed horse show and is held in conjunction with the World Championship Appaloosa Youth Show. This years World Championship Appaloosa Show will be held at the Will Rogers Equestrian Center in Fort Worth, Texas. All three events bring in talented exhibitors from around the world.

The annual Chief Joseph Trail Ride will be held this year in July. A portion of the 1,100 mile historic trail is ridden each year with the entire sequence taking 13 years to complete and brings riders and Appaloosa lovers from all over the country.

Since 2006, the ApHC has joined with multiple breed associations to offer an annual 50-mile and 100-mile championship endurance ride and a 40-mile competitive trail ride. This year, these rides will take place in Menahga, MN in September and October.


