- Find your center on each circle
- Ride the horse you have today don't overshow!
- Ride at least three strides past your marker
- · Know your penalties. Is it better to do a simple change or miss your lead for a quarter of a circle?
- · Think correct first, then degree of difficulty and then quality of maneuvers
- The rulebook is your answer to all questions. Know your rules
