

Ranch Rail Pleasure -

- · Show off your horse's movement, versatility and attitude
- It's not a western pleasure class. It's a natural, forward-moving style (as if you have somewhere to go)
- · Horse should be bright and attentive. Working his ears, paying attention to rider
- · Horse needs to look as if he can cover some ground and is soft to ride
- · Horse must have a natural carriage, moving freely but responsive to the rider
- In extended gaits; you need to see the horse going some place in order for it to be credit earning. Make it so you can see a difference in gaits.
- The super loose rein you see in Western Pleasure classes should never be used in ranch pleasure
