Registering Your Horse Online

The ApHC introduced our online registration system this summer! If you are an ApHC member, you can now register using this process. Follow the steps below to register your horse online!

- 1. Go to appaloosa.com
- 2. Click on <u>Log In</u> located on the top right corner of the screen.
- 3. Insert your member portal User ID and password.
- 4. Click on My Registration Application
- 5. Click Create New Registration Application
 - a. Stipulations to register your horse include:
 - i. You must be the recorded owner of the dam at the time of foaling
 - ii. If you have a Parent that is an Approved Outcross you must file both the non-appaloosa listing application and DNA prior to completing the online registration.
 - iii. All foals are required to be DNA tested using this online registration program
 - iv. The stallion breeding report must be on file prior to applying for registration.
