Reserve Champion: Elayne Barclay riding Mt Mists Topaz Moon (owned by Elayne Barclay) ■

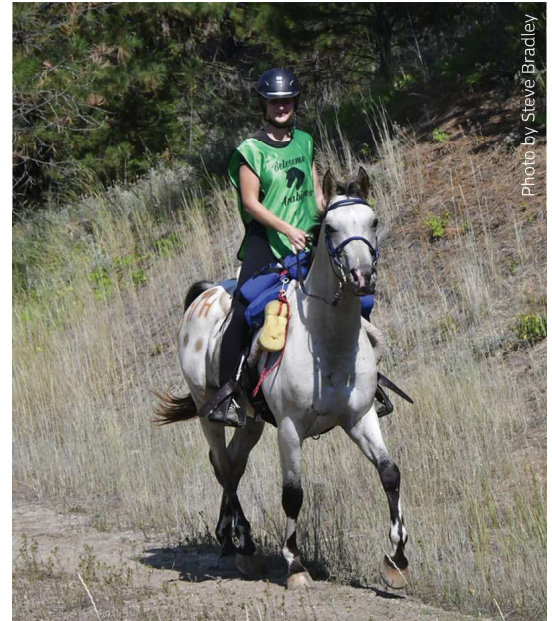

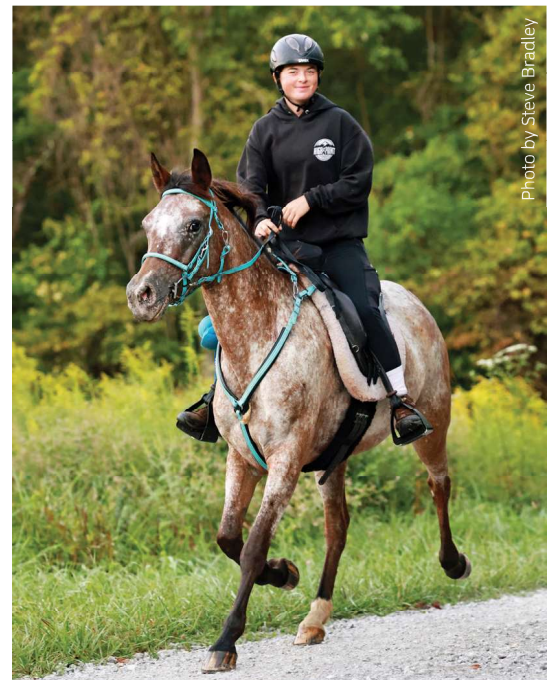
