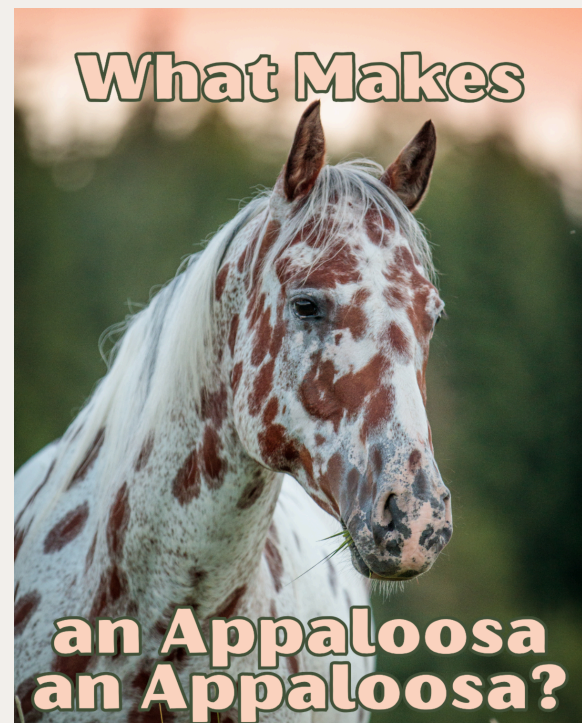


AYA Genetics Seminar

Sale Graduate Sets Stakes Record at Remington Park

An Appaloosa mare that passed through the sale ring earlier this year quickly proved her value on the racetrack.

Cowgirl Chaos, who sold for \$32,000 at the Heritage Place Winter Mixed Sale in Oklahoma City, returned to the winner's circle in March with a record-setting performance in the Paul Harber Memorial Stakes at Remington Park.

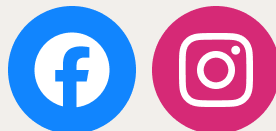
The 4-year-old mare captured the 300-yard stakes for Paints and Appaloosas in a thrilling three-horse finish, stopping the clock in 15.375 to set a new stakes record.

The time broke the previous mark and highlighted one of the standout performances of the early 2026 racing season at Remington Park.

The victory adds to Cowgirl Chaos' growing race résumé and provides another example of the quality horses that emerge from the Heritage Place sale ring.
