



ApHC BOXING REFERENCE SHEET

50 Second Time Limit

1 Whistle to Terminate Work

2 Whistles to Award New Cow

Scoring for both rein work and cow work will be from 60-80 with 70 denoting average

1 Point Penalty:

- Loss of working advantage
- Working out of position
- Excessive hollering

3 Point Penalty:

- Loss of control and animal leaves the end of the arena

5 Point Penalty:

- Blatant, disobedience, defined as kicking, biting, rearing, striking or obvious in subordination

Score 0:

- Turn tail to the cow
- Use of 2 hand on reins when using a bridle or two-rein equipment
- Fingers between the reins, except when using a two-rein outfit
- Balking
- Extremely out of control
- Bloody mouth
- Illegal equipment
- Leaving the work area before the pattern or work is complete
- Fall of horse or rider
- Schooling of the horse between the rein work and cow work
- Schooling of the horse between cows if a new cow is awarded
- Improper western attire

No Score:

- Lameness of the horse
- Abuse

Failure of the exhibitor to attempt to complete work (call for cow) will result in exhibitor not being eligible for points or placing and will not be counted as an entry in the class.

Reined work for boxing classes: Scored 60-80 using working cow horse patterns and scoring guidelines.

Credits:

- Maintaining control of the cow at all times
- Maintaining proper position
- Degree of difficulty
- Eye appeal
- Time worked
