Scoring: 0-100 with 70 denoting the average. Maneuvers are scored +1½ to -1½ in ½ point increments

5-point penalty

- Failure to change leads
- Blatant disobedience
- Use of free hand to instill fear or praise
- Holding saddle with either hand

3-point penalty

- Not performing the specific gait or not stopping when called for, within 10 feet
- Break of gait at lope
- Simple lead change
- Incorrect lead before or after cone
- Additional lead changes
- In patterns one and three, failure to start the lope within 30 feet after crossing log
- Break of gait at walk or jog for two or more strides

1-point penalty

- Break of gait at walk or jog, two strides or less
- Hitting or rolling log
- Out of lead more than one stride to the cone
- Split pole in lope-over
- Hind legs skipping or coming together during lead change
- Non-simultaneous lead change

½ -point penalty

- Each tick of log

Disqualifications

- Fall to ground by horse or exhibitor
- Illegal equipment
- Willful abuse
- Off course - incomplete pattern, incorrect order of maneuvers or passing on wrong side of marker
- Knocking over a marker
- Completely missing log
- Major refusal
- Major disobedience or schooling
- Failure to start lope prior to end cone in pattern one
- Four or more simple lead changes or four failures to change leads
- Overturns of more than ¼ turn
