	Crest: The upper part of the neck, from the withers to the ears.
	Croup: The sloping part of the hip between the tail and the loin.
—	Fetlock: The leg joint above the pastern and below the cannon bones.
—	Forearm: The upper part of the front leg; from the horse's elbow to the knee.
	Gaskin: The muscular part of the hind leg above the hock.
	Hock: The joint in the hind leg that works like the ankle, allowing bend of the lower leg.
	Pastern: The area between the fetlock joint and the coronet band.
	Poll: The bony area lying between the ears.
—	Stifle: The joint between the hip and the hock; is similar to the human knee.
	Throatlatch: The point where the horse's head attaches to the neck.
	Withers: The highest point of the horse's shoulders.
